

## Online Giving?

For months, our deacon over finances, Justin Thornton, had been exploring different options for online giving that we might use at Southgate. Our current situation with the coronavirus has allowed us to go ahead and launch a secure way for you to give online if that's more convenient for you.

You simply go to the church's website:

<http://www.southgatecofc.com/>

From there go to the bottom of the page and click on the blue box that says, "Give Online".

When you click there, it will ask your information, and will take a donation either by credit card, or a bank draft.

Two other options you have when you donate online:

1. You can make a one-time donation, and do that every week, or set up a recurring donation where your contribution is automatically made every week for you.

2. There's also a box you can check if you want to cover the fee for a transaction so the church won't have to pay that fee (for instance, for a \$50 donation, the fee is \$1.75, so your contribution would be \$51.75).

Of course, you may still mail in your contribution, bring it by the church office, or if you are meeting with a small group, give your contribution there where it will be collected and brought to the office.

The online giving is just another way of making our contribution that makes it a bit easier to do.
