The mission of the Children's Advocacy Center is to improve services to child victims of abuse. The Children's Advocacy Center has been working at this mission in San Angelo and surrounding counties for more than 20 years.

Perhaps you've already donated a duffle but find yourself wondering what more can I do to help kids in our community? One opportunity is to become a CASA volunteer with the Children's Advocacy Center. Even if you just have a few hours a month to volunteer, your help is needed.

CASA stands for Court Appointed Special Advocate. When a home is no longer safe for a child and the child must enter the foster care system, a judge may appoint a committed volunteer. The volunteer's focus is on the child, providing hope and help in guiding the child to a safe permanent home. Volunteer's mission is to speak for the best interest of abused and neglected children whose future home will be determined by a Court of Law. CASA's goal is to provide each child a safe, permanent, and nurturing home.

CASA Volunteers made a real difference in the lives of children and families who come to the Children's Advocacy Center. With the help of caring volunteers like you, the Children's Advocacy Center can continue to promote child abuse prevention and provide our local children with safe and nurturing homes.
