

Cache Cole is a member of the Family Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA) in Eden, which is an organization for high school students, that promotes personal growth and leadership. It is a national organization with chapters in 49 states and several US territories.

Participation in FCCLA contests is strictly voluntary and all of the activities are created and implemented by the students. All of their service outreaches have been community focused, inspiring the community to help each other. That is the overall focus of FCCLA, to create family and community leaders.

With the community projects that Cache and his friends did this past year, (they hosted a "Father/Son" event to promote families to spend quality time with each other, and they raised money to provide a full Thanksgiving meal for 20 families in Concho County) they presented their project at FCCLA Regional competition. They advanced to state in April where they received a 1st place rating. These contests are not based on school size, 1A schools compete against 6A schools. They will be going to the national contest in late June.
