When your time to answer others concerning your faith, Peter gives us simple instructions.

I Peter 3:15 says... “...*but in your hearts reverence Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to make a defense to any one who calls you to account for the hope that is in you, yet do it with gentleness and reverence;...*”

Here, the Apostle tells us:

- 1. Be prepared to make our defense. We do not have to know the answer to every possible question, but we do need to know something.**
- 2. When asked, we must know why we have hope. What causes us to have confidence.**
- 3. When we answer, we are to do so with a gentle spirit.**
- 4. When we answer, we are to have reverence toward Christ.**
- 5. We will never know the answer to every possible question, but we must know why we have hope. When we know that and when we answer with gentleness and reverence, we will be a good witness for Jesus.**
