

Psalm 1 - Two Types of People!

“Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the wicked, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of scoffers; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and on his law he meditates day and night.

He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers.

The wicked are not so, but are like chaff that the wind drives away. Therefore the wicked will not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous; for the Lord knows the way of the righteous, but the way of the wicked will perish.” Psalms 1:1-6.

This passage describes two different sets of people. It describes people who will not be able to stand in the Day of Judgment. If you can't stand, I guess it means you will fall. The other set of people are those who stand with God and are blessed by Him.

Those who will be rejected are those who walk within the counsel of the wicked. They stand with sinners and wind up sitting—living with—scoffers. That means those who will be rejected by God are those who take their advice from the wicked, who take a stand against God, and finally make fun of the righteous. Because they are against God, they will face Him in judgment alone. It will not be a pretty sight.

But those who are approved by God love God's word. They ever want to know its meaning. They long to understand. They are those who like to go to Bible class. They will be blessed by God. Everything they do will prosper because they stand with 'He who supplies everything'. They are like a tree planted next to a river. They thrive.
