

# **“ YOUR CALL ”**

**Peter wrote to Christians who were scattered and harassed. He reminded them of their great salvation. He reminded them of the great sacrifice Christ made. He reminded them of their great hope. Then he began to tell them what that would mean in their daily life. Since we answered a “Call” to Christ, our behavior is already determined. He tells us, in I Peter, chapter 2. He tells us we are called to holiness. The world is not holy but we are. He called us to light (I Peter 2:9) in a world that is very dark. We are called to light. Even though we are surrounded by evil doers, we are called to good deeds (I Peter 2:12). Later, we are told we are called to endure (I Peter 2:21).**

**Sometimes we are mistreated and misunderstood. Sometimes no one is interested in what you think. You may have to endure it, but you endure as a Christian.**

**Sometimes wives, your husband is not the man you thought he was. You are called to be a Christian. Husbands, sometimes your wife is not what she ought to be. You are called to be a Christian. Sometimes, those who have authority are not wise or kind or fair. Maybe they listen; maybe they don't, but you are still a Christian.**

**Why not try reading I Peter and insert yourself in the scripture. Then ask yourself, “To what have I been called?”**
